Roberts has been selected for the **Nando's Creative Exchange Programme 2023**. As part of the NCX Programme, her work will be exhibited at the **GFI Gallery in Port Elizabeth** in 2023.

In 2023, Mellaney showcased at **THE 2020's: New Forms of Abstraction – Part 2** at **Berman Contemporary**. Since 2023, she has participated in various group exhibitions at Berman Contemporary.

In 2024, her works were showcased at **Ceramic Brussels** with Berman Contemporary, as well as **Investec Cape Town Art Fair**.

1 Exploring Creativity Through Art & Words

Call and Response: Art Beyond Borders, is a collaborative, reflective exploration of creativity, community, and interconnectedness.

Participants are invited to submit a **personal verse or phrase** that reflects their thoughts, a memory, emotions, or observations about themselves, their classmates, and their surroundings.

These submissions will serve as a "**call**" to which participants respond by selecting one of the phrases and creating an artwork that visually represents or interprets the chosen text.

This dialogue between words and visual art encourages students to engage deeply with each other's ideas, fostering a **sense of shared identity** and a heightened awareness of their environment.
